## **Answer**

(a) & (b) India shares 4096.7 Km of its land border with Bangladesh. West Bengal, Assam, Meghalaya, Tripura and Mizoram are the States which share the border with Bangladesh. The State-wise length of the borders is as under:

Assam 263.00
Meghalaya 443.00
Tripura 856.00
Mizoram 318.00
TOTAL 4096.70

The entire stretch consist of plain, riverine, hilly/jungle and with hardly any natural obstacles.
