Will the Minister of LAW AND JUSTICE be pleased to state:

(a) the number of eligible persons applied for and provided with the free legal services by various legal services institutions under Section 12 of The Legal Services Authorities Act, 1987 in the country during each of the last three years and the current year, State/UT-wise;

(b) the total number of various legal services institutions under the said Act presently functioning in the country, State/ UT-wise;

(c) the measures taken/being taken by the Government to ensure accountability and transparency by the legal aid professionals/advocates engaged therein;

(d) whether any of such legal services institutions are functional in all the law colleges in the country and if so, the details thereof; and

(e) the details of funds allocated/released by the Government for the purpose during the said period, State/UT-wise?

MINISTER OF STATE FOR LAW AND JUSTICE AND ELECTRONICS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (SHRI P.P. CHAUDHARY)

(a) A total number of 49,79,707 eligible persons were provided free legal services by various legal services institutions during the last three calendar years and the current year 2016 (upto March, 2016). A statement showing State/UT-wise and year-wise number of beneficiaries who were provided free legal services is at Annexure-A.

(b) A statement showing State/UT-wise total number of Legal Services Institutions presently functioning in the country under the Legal Services Authorities Act, 1987 is at Annexure-B.

(c) All eligible persons are provided free legal services through the competent panel advocates. While preparing the panel of lawyers, the competence, integrity, suitability and experience of such lawyers are taken into account by the Legal Services Institutions. If the panel lawyers engaged is not performing satisfactorily or has acted contrary to the object and spirit of the Legal Services Authorities Act, 1987 and the National Legal Services Authority (Free and Competent Legal Services) Regulation, 2010, the Legal Services Institutions take appropriate steps including withdrawal of the case from such lawyer and his removal from the panel. The Monitoring Committee constituted under the Regulations, 2010 also monitors the Court based legal services rendered and progress of the case in legal aid matters. The Monitoring Committee is required to send periodic reports to the Chairman of the District Legal Services Authority.

(d) The National Legal Services Authority (Legal Aid Clinics) Regulations, 2011 provide for setting up legal aid clinics in the law colleges, law universities and other institutions as a part of the clinical legal education. As on 31.01.2016, 1575 such clinics have been set up in schools/ colleges/ universities in the country.

(e) A statement showing the details of financial assistance provided to State Legal Services Authorities during the last three calendar years and the current year 2016 for implementing various legal aid activities including providing free legal services to eligible persons is at Annexure-C.
