(b) if so, the details thereof during each of the last three years and the funds allocated and spent for this purpose?

(a)to(b)Rural roads is a State subject and Pradhan MantriGram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) is a onetime special intervention of Government of India to improve rural infrastructure through construction of roads in rural areas of the country which is executed by the State Rural Roads Development Agencies (SRRDAs)at State level and Programme Implementation Units (PIUs) at district levels. In order to augment the execution capacity of the States,in the last three years, the Ministry of Rural Development, Government of India along with concerned SRRDAs has entered into tri-partite agreements with M/s Indian Railway Construction Company (IRCON), National Building Construction Corporation Ltd (NBCC) and National Projects Construction Corporation Ltd (NPCC) as per the details given below:
