Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the status of various schemes and programmes under the rural development that are fully integrated to the direct benefit transfer scheme;
- (b) whether the Government is aware of various incidents where the beneficiaries are made proxies and the sums credited to them are used by others;
- (c) if so, the measures taken to prevent such incidents;
- (d) whether the Government is aware of beneficiaries of schemes, especially women being denied enrolment in various schemes by local officials and implementing agencies; and
- (e) if so, the steps taken to prevent such incidents?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI UPENDRA KUSHWAHA)

- (a) :The Ministry of Rural Development, inter alia, is implementing various rural development programmes in rural areas of the country namely, Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act (MGNREGA), Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY), National Rural Livelihood Mission (NRLM), Indira Awaas Yojana (IAY), National Social Assistance Programme (NSAP) and Integrated Watershed Management Programme (IWMP) as a part of the overall planning process through State Governments and UT Administrations. The Ministry has identified 289 focus districts for implementation of Aadhaar enabled Direct Benefits Transfer (DBT) towards wage and pension payment under Mahatma Gandhi NREGA and NSAP. All States/UTs have been requested to credit wages payable under Mahatma Gandhi NREGA directly into the respective beneficiary accounts using core banking system. E-FMS with Post Offices (Sanchaya Post) has been attempted to ensure real time fund flow to the worker's Post Office Account.
