- (b) the details of the expenditure incurred by Air India/NACIL on the purchase of these aircraft during the last three years and the current year; and
- (c) whether Air India has entered into any agreement for purchase of aircraft and if so, the details thereof?

- (a): Details of the number and type of aircraft in the fleet of Air India along with the name of the company from which these aircraft have been purchased is annexed.
- (b): The total amount spent on aircraft purchased from Boeing during the last 3 years i.e. 2011-12, 2012-13, 2013-14 and the current year 2014-15 is furnished below:

(c): Air India had signed a Purchase Agreement with Boeing in 2005 for acquisition of 50 aircraft which includes 8 B777-200LR, 15 B777-300 LR and 27 B787 aircraft. So far, 8 units of B777-200 LR, 12 unit of B777-300 ER and 16 unit of B787 aircrafts have been delivered. Air India had also entered into an agreement for purchase of 43 Airbus aircraft with Airbus Industries in 2006. All 43 aircraft have been delivered.
