- (b) to (d): Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) has issued Civil Aviation Requirement Section 3, Air Transport, Series M, Part I on `Carriage by air persons with disability and/or Persons with reduced mobility` (Annexure-I) and Air Transport Circular No. 01 of 2014 on `Facilities/Courtesies to esteemed travelling public at airports` (Annexure-II). The regulation issued by DGCA is mandatory for compliance by airport operator and airlines.
