- (b) whether there is any provision/proposal for compensation to such deathsof MGNREGS workers while working; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof?

## MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI UPENDRA KUSHWAHA)

- (a) Information on death of Mahatma GandhiNational Rural Employment Guarantee Act (MGNREGA) workers due to accidents while working is maintained by the respective Programme Officers and not centrally maintained by the Ministry.
- (b)& (c)Yes, Madam.As per Paragraph 27 of Scheduled II of MGNREGA, 2005, if a person employed under the Scheme meets with death or becomes permanently disabled by accident arising out of and in the course of employment, he or his legal heirs, as the case may be, shall be paid by the implementing agency an ex-gratiaas per entitlements under the Aam Aadmi BimaYojana or as may be notified by the Central Government.
