## Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has any proposal to allow international airlines to operate ultra long-haul planes 'Airbus 380s' into the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with its likely impact on Indian carriers; and
- (c) whether Indian Airports can handle these planes and if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

## **Answer**

Minister of State in the Ministry of CIVIL AVIATION (Shri G.M. Siddeshwara)

(a) to (c): The Government has recently allowed international airlines operation of A-380 aircraft in India at Delhi, Mumbai, Hyderabad and Bengaluru airports, which are equipped to handle A-380 operations. It is expected that there would be no impact on Indian carriers as the operation of A-380 by international airlines is allowed subject to the overall traffic entitlements within bilateral Air Services Agreement with various countries.
