- (b) if so, the details of such airports along with the losses incurred by them during the last three years and the current year; and
- (c) the steps taken or being taken by the Government to make these airports viable and profitable?

- (a) & (b): Yes, Madam. The details of airports which have incurred losses during the last three years are at Annexure-I.;
- (c): The following steps have been taken/being taken by the Airports Authority of India to make loss making airports viable and profitable:;
- (i) Development of cargo activities.;
- (ii) Enhancement of non-aero revenue through revision of rates and awarding of contracts through master concessions.;
- (iii) Allowing operation of flying schools at non-operational airports.;
- (iv) Encouraging MRO activities.;
- (v) Revision of base rates.;
