- (c) whether the Government has received any objections from certain States regarding construction of these airports; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof along with the action taken by the Government in this regard?

Answer

- (a)&(b):Yes, Madam. Govt. of India has granted `in principle` approval for setting up of 15 Greenfield airports in various States of the country. The present status of these airports along with estimated project cost are at Annexure-I.
- (c):No, Madam. Greenfield airports are given 'in-principle' approval after getting support letter from the concerned State Governments;
