**Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether Air India has introduced the Dreamliner service as passenger flights in domestic and international sector;
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the number of dreamliners introduced for this purpose, sector-wise;
- (c) whether the Government has any plan to start the Dreamliner service to Kerala and if so, the details thereof along with the time by which it is likely to be introduced; and
- (d) the details of dreamliner accidents reported after its introduction along with the reasons therefor and the steps taken or being taken to avoid these accidents?
