- (b) & (c): Yes, Madam. Some private empanelled hospitals have withdrawn their services from ECHS due to various reasons including low CGHS rates, delay in payment of dues etc.
- (i)On line bill processing has been introduced in 10 Regional Centres to speed up bill clearance. Sanction has been accorded to extend 'on-line' bill processing to remaining 18 Regional Centres for expeditious clearance of dues.
- (ii) Delegation of Financial Powers for approval of hospital bills has been enhanced to facilitate speedy disposal of medical bills / claims.
