(a) & (b) Yes, Madam. The Detailed Project Report (DPR) for Modernisation of Narayanpur Left Bank Canal was cleared during 121st meeting of Technical Advisory Committee of Ministry of Water Resources for Irrigation, Flood Control and Multipurpose projects held on 8.10.2013 for an estimated cost of Rs.3752.18 crore (price level 2012-13). Investment Clearance of the project has been accorded by the Planning Commission on 16.12.2013.
