- (e) the other steps being taken or proposes to be taken by the Government for maintaining peace and security along Indo-China border areas?

Answer

MINISTER OF DEFENCE (SHRI ARUN JAITLEY)

- (a) to (d): Yes, Madam. Chairman Chiefs of Staff Committee (COSC) and Chief of Army Staff (COAS) visited China from 2-5 July 2014 and held discussions on a wide range of issues of defence and security. No Agreement / Memorandum of Understanding was signed during the visit.
- (e) India has signed Agreements in past with China for maintenance of peace and tranquility on the India-China border. Further, Government takes adequate measures to safeguard the territorial integrity, sovereignty and security by reviewing the threat perception from time to time.
