Will the Minister of TEXTILES be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of handloom weavers employed in the country, State/UT-wise;
- (b) whether the Government has provided special package/financial assistance/subsidy to the State Governments for handloom sectors and concessional credits to the handloom weavers during each of the last three years and the current year;
- (c) if so, the details thereof, State/UTwise; and
- (d) the number of handloom weavers benefited therefrom during the said period, State/UT-wise, Scheme-wise?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) IN THE MINISTRY OF TEXTILES (SHRI SANTOSH KUMAR GANGWAR)

- (a): As per handloom census (2009-10), there are 43,31,876 handloom weavers and allied workers in the country. The State-wises detail is given at Annexure-I.
- (b) to (d): The Government of India, in November, 2011, has approved Revival, Reform and Restructuring (RRR) package for waiver of overdue loan (100% principal and 25% of interest by GOI and 75% interest and penalty, if any, by Banks) as on 31/3/2010 and to provide recapitalization assistance to eligible apex and primary weavers cooperative societies & individual weavers. The RRR Package has been implemented upto 28.02.2014 through NABARD, the implementing agency. The State-wise details of waiver of overdue loan and recapitalization assistance approved under RRR package is given in Annexure-II.

Further, to provide access to subsidized credit, the government approved Institutional credit component in December, 2011. Under this component, the Government provided 3 % interest subvention for 3 years, margin money assistance @ Rs.4200/ per weaver and credit guarantee through Credit Guarantee Trust Fund for micro & Small Enterprises (CGTMSE). The incentives have been further modified and now loan is given to handloom weavers at 6% interest with Gol interest subvention upto max.7% and margin money assistance has also been enhanced upto Rs. 10,000 per weaver. The State-wise details of loan sanctioned & weavers covered by the banks is given in Annexure-III.
