- (e) the steps taken/being taken by the Government to ensure availability of iron ore to all sectors in the country and to regulate its export?

- (e): To conserve natural resources and to meet the domestic demand, duty on export of iron ore has been increased from 20% to 30% ad valorem basis on all grades of iron ore (except pellets) with effect from 30.12.2011. Export duty of 5% has been imposed on iron ore pellets with effect from 27.01. 2014.
