(a) and (b): The Ministry of Rural Development, inter alia, is implementing major rural development programme, viz., Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act (MGNREGA), Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana-Gramin (PMAY-G, erstwhile Indira Awaas Yojana (IAY)), Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY), Deendayal Antodaya Yojana-National Rural Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NRLM), Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Grameen Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY) and National Social Assistance Programme (NSAP).
