As per the guidelines of NBA, provision of incentives for construction of Individual household latrines have been made for all Below Poverty Lines (BPLs) as well as Above Poverty Lines (APLs) belonging to ST category w.e.f. 1.4.2012. The State/UT wise fund released under NBA under TSP during last 3 years and current year is at Annexure-1.
