- (d) if so, the details of the countries so identified and the other changes made by the Government in this regard to admission in IITs for Scheduled Caste/ Scheduled Tribe and Persons with Disability (PWD)category candidates;
- (e) whether the Directors of IITs have opposed this move of outsourcing students in IITs; and
- (f) if so, the reasons put forward by them and other steps taken or being taken by the Government for smooth conducting of admission in IITs?

(a) to (d): Foreign students have been allowed to register for JEE (Advanced) 2017 and the seats allotted to them are supernumerary with a cap of 10% of total number of seats in each course. It has also been decided to conduct JEE (Advanced) 2017 examination in 6 examination centres abroad, namely Addis Ababa (Ethiopia), Colombo (Sri Lanka), Dhaka (Bangladesh), Dubai (UAE), Kathmandu (Nepal) and Singapore. For SC/ST students the qualifying marks in the 12th Class exam have been relaxed from 75% to 65%.
