India also coordinates with the member countries of South Asian Association of Regional Cooperation (SAARC) and Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN) countries on technical cooperation on various issues of climate change.
- (c) These countries support for evolving common stands on issues of climate change relating to developing countries under the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) negotiating process and also participating in technical and scientific cooperation on various aspects of climate change.
