**Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:**

- (a) the total number of National Highway projects undertaken in the State of Haryana during the last three years, district-wise;
- (b) the total expenditure incurred by the Government on these projects, district-wise;
- (c) the proposals pending with the Government regarding construction of National Highway in the State of Haryana; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

**Answer**

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI KRISHANPAL GURJAR)

(a) to (d) The National Highways (NHs) are main arterial roads and their development/upgradation are taken up considering overall connectivity in the country. The National Highway projects are taken up through different implementing agencies for different stretches/section-wise for NHs but not district-wise. Details regarding expenditure incurred by this Ministry on NH projects with State PWD during last three years in Haryana are as follows:

Year	Amount (Rs. in crore)
2011-12	98.16
2012-13	78.80
2013-14	53.51

Further under National Highways Development Project, 4-laning of NH-71A of Rohtak-Panipat section, NH-71 Rohtak-Bawal section, NH-71 Rohtak-Jind section, NH-71 Jind -Haryana Border section and NH-10 Rohtak-Hisar section have been undertaken during last three years on Built Operate & Transfer [BOT (Toll)] basis in Haryana.
