CONSTRUCTION OF OVERBRIDGES IN CHHATTISGARH

**Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:**

- (a) the total number of overbridges proposed in Chhattisgarh from Champa to Korba and from Champa to Bilaspur;
- (b) the present status of the proposed overbridges in the State;
- (c) whether the construction work of overbridge at Champa-Birra National Highway 49 has been stopped by the Government;
- (d) if so, the reasons therefor; and
- (e) the time by which construction work of overbridge is likely to be started?

**Answer**

- (a) & (b) Three number of over-bridges are proposed in Chhattisgarh from Champa to Korba and from Champa to Bilaspur, out of which construction of two number of over-bridges are in progress.
- (c) to (e) Construction work of one overbridge at Champa-Birra National Highway 49 has been stopped due to non availability of land for construction. The work will be taken-up, once the land is made available for construction.
