(a) to (d) The tenders for award of work covering a length of 13km Kollam Bypass on Kavanadu-Kallumthazham-Mevaram section on NH-66 (old NH-47) which includes construction of three major bridges across streams of Astamudi lake in aggregate length of 1,540m have been invited. The time frame for completion of bypass work including three major bridges is 30 months after award of the work.
