- (c) if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) whether the Government also proposes to construct a four lane road from Ayodhya to Chitrakoot via Rigvedpur Bhardwaj Marg etc. and bridges on Ganga river and Yamuna river and if so, the details thereof?

- (a) National Highway from Allahabad to Lucknow is likely to be completed by June, 2015.
- (b) to (d) Ministry has invited bids for consultancy services for capacity augmentation of NH-96 & NH-97, through which Ayodhya and Chitrakoot are connected. Based upon the consultancy report, decision for capacity augmentation to 2 lane with paved shoulder/four lane and construction of additional bridges on Ganga and Yamuna will be taken
