(a) & (b): The National Police Mission under the Bureau of Police Research & Development (BPR&D) have prepared a plan proposal on 'Community Counselling Centre' for implementation in the States of Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Himachal Pradesh and Chhattisgarh during the 12th Five Year Plan on pilot basis. The proposal prepared by BPR&D has been received in the Ministry of Home Affairs. The proposal envisages setting up of a Community Counselling Centre inside a Police Station premises and engage Police Personnel, Counsellors, Community Liaison Group Members and Non-Governmental Organisations to receive and address the grievances of the victims. The implementation of the proposal is subject to availability of funds, consent of the State Governments and other agencies, proposed to be engaged in the project implementation.
