Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the funds sanctioned for the development of infrastructure in Himachal Pradesh under the Integrated Infrastructure Development Scheme (IIDS) have not been released so far;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise;
- (c) the reasons for the delay along with the present status of the above cases; and
- (d) the time by which the said amount is likely to be released to the State Governments?

Answer

(a): In the State of Himachal Pradesh, one Infrastructure Development Project at Gwalthai, District-Bilaspur was approved on 06.05.1997 at a total project cost of Rs.432.00 lakh under IID Scheme. The eligible Gol grant of Rs.124.41 lakh was released. No, further, Gol funds are pending for release;
