- (a) whether the Government proposes to set up multi-model logistic parks around major cities which have share of about 50% of country's freight movement by road;

- (c) the total investment likely to be made for setting up these logistic parks;
- (d) whether the Government has simplified the procedure and has taken all the stakeholders into confidence for smooth functioning of these parks; and
- (e) the extent to which this step of the Government is likely to reduce transport cost of goods and the stage at which this proposal is at present?

(a) to (e) With a view to facilitating efficient and seamless freight movement in the country, it has been decided to develop Logistic Parks at different locations in the country through active collaboration between the National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) and stakeholders such as State Government and relevant Ministries like Railway, Shipping and Civil Aviation, after due consultation with all concerned agencies.
