- (a) the details of various developmental programmes undertaken along with the amount allocated and utilised by States under various programme during each of the last three years and the current year, State-wise including Jharkhand;
- (b) whether there is any delay in the implementation of these programmes;
- (c) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor; and
- (d) the steps taken/proposed to be taken by the Government in this regard?

Answer

MINISTER OF MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES (SHRI KALRAJ MISHRA)

- (a): The Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME) has been implementing various schemes/programmes across the country including Jharkhand. The major schemes/programmes include Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP), Credit Guarantee Scheme, Credit Linked Capital Subsidy Scheme (CLCSS), National Manufacturing Competitiveness Programme, Cluster Development Programme, Marketing Development Assistance, Skill Development Programmes, International Cooperation Scheme etc. All plan schemes implemented by Ministry of MSME are Central Sector Schemes, therefore funds are not allocated State-wise, under these schemes.
- (b) to (d): No Madam, the plan schemes meant for Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) being implemented by Ministry of MSME are of continuing nature.
