- (d) whether the Government has received any proposal from Rajasthan for augmenting the production capacity of Chambal Fertilizers and Chemicals Limited; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof and the action taken/proposed to be taken by the Government in this regard?

- (b): The requirement, production, imports and availability of urea, DAP, MOP & NPK for last year is as given below:-
