- (a) whether vigilance committees have been constituted in the States including Maharashtra to conduct surprise inspection of works undertaken under Swachh Bharat Mission (SBM);
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether separate funds have been allocated for the construction of toilets and sewer lines in rural areas in the country under Swachh Bharat Mission-Gramin; and
- (d) if so, the amount of funds allocated during each of the last three years and the current financial year, State-wise including Maharashtra?

- (a) and (b) The government has constituted DISHA (District Development Coordination and Monitoring Committee) under the chairmanship of Local Member of Parliament to monitor various Centrally Sponsored Schemes including the Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin).
- (c) Under Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin), funds are not allocated component-wise.
- (d) State/UT-wise, Central share released during the last three years and the current year is at Annexure-1.
