(a) to (c) Madam, a Memorandum of Understanding was signed between Department of Posts and Ministry of Railways on 31.7.2007 to issue reserved rail tickets through Posts Offices under Passenger Reservation System. The reserved rail tickets are issued from 291 Posts Offices as of now.
