(a) the total number of medical colleges running under the Employees State Insurance Corporation (ESIC) in the country along with the total number of workers covered thereunder, State/UT-wise;

(b) whether the ESIC/Government proposes to set up new Medical Colleges/Super Speciality Hospitals in various parts of the country and if so, the details thereof along with the locations identified and funds allocated for the purpose, State/UT-wise including Uttar Pradesh;

(c)the details of the facilities available in such medical colleges/super speciality hospitals along with the number of persons benefited therefrom during the last three years and the current year, State/UT-wise;

(d) whether the ESIC hospitals have adequate medical facilities to cater to the needs of their beneficiaries; and

(e)if so, the details thereof along with the reaction of the Government there to and the steps being taken by the Government to augment the same?

(a): Employees' State Insurance (ESI) Corporation is running six Medical Colleges across the country. The details along with total number of workers/insured Persons (IP) covered, state/UT-wise are as at Annexure-I. Contd..2/-

- (b): The ESIC had decided in 165th meeting held on 7/4/2015 that it will neither set up any other Medical College nor any new Medical Education Institution. The ESI Corporation in its 167th meeting has taken a decision to run one super specialty hospital in every State. During same meeting, in-principle approval has also been given for setting up of a Super Speciality Hospital at Pandu Nagar, Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh at the cost of Rs. 300 crore.
- (c): The details of facilities available in associated in Medical College hospitals are at Annexure-II. ESIC is running a super speciality hospital at Sanath nagar, Hyderabad with super specialities such as Cardiology, Neurology, Neurosurgery, Pediatrics surgery, nephrology, urology, dialysis etc. The details of in-house Super-speciality Services provided in ESIC Hospital is at Annexure-III. Total number of IPs for last three years is at Annexure-IV.
- (d) & (e): ESIC hospitals have adequate medical facilities, either in-house or through tie-up arrangements, to cater to the needs of ESI beneficiaries. Details of recent steps taken to augment medical facilities, are as under:
- a. Availability of electronic health records of patients.
- b. Day-wise change of hospitals bed sheets
- c. 24X7 medical helpline.
- d. Evening OPD for senior Citizen & differently able patients.
- e. Cancer detection/ treatment facilities.
- f. Cardiology treatment facilities.
- g. Setting up of Dialysis facilities.
- h. Complete immunization facilities.
- i. Telemedicine and AYUSH facilities.
