- (a)&(b): Yes Madam. The Functional Plan on Transport for National Capital Region-2032 which was approved by the National Capital Region Planning Board (NCRPB) in 2009, includes Regional Rapid Transit System (RRTS), Mass Rapid Transit System (MRTS), Expressways, Highways, Roads, Railway, Logistics Hub etc. Details of estimated cost is at Annexure.
- (c): National Capital Region Planning Board (NCRPB) is a Planning Board for the region. The Functional Plan on Transport for National Capital Region-2032 is implemented by participating State Governments/Union Territories and Central Government Ministries in four phases, i.e., Phase-I (2010-2013), Phase-II (2013-2017), Phase-III (2018-2022), Phase-IV (2023-2032).
