Will the Minister of URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the percentage of urban households getting drinking water through piped water supply connections as on date;
- (b) whether the Government proposes to cover 100 percent urban households under piped water supply connections;
- (c) if so, the details thereof and the action taken/being taken by the Government in this regard;
- (d) the time by which all urban households in the country will be provided with pipe connections; and
- (e) the details of assistance provided to States for the same?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT (SHRI M. VENKAIAH NAIDU)

- (a): As per Census of India 2011, 70.6% of urban population is covered by piped water supply connections.
- (b) to (d): It has been targeted in the 12th Five Year Plan document on urban water supply that all the households would be covered with piped water supply during the Plan (2012 AD 2017 AD).

Water Supply is a State subject and Ministry of Urban Development (MoUD) supplements the efforts of State Governments/ Urban Local Bodies (ULBs) in providing adequate water supply facilities in urban areas under various schemes such as Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission (JNNURM), 10% Lumpsum Scheme for North Eastern States, North Eastern Region Urban Development Programme (NERUDP) with ADB assistance and Urban Infrastructure Development Scheme for Satellite towns/Counter Magnets of Million plus cities (UIDSST). In addition, various policies and advisories are issued by MoUD from time to time.

(e): The details of financial assistance provided to States are as under:-
