- (a) the details of projects sanctioned under Namami Gange Mission as on September 30, 2016;
- (b) the estimated cost of these sanctioned projects along with the expenditure incurred thereon; and
- (c) the achievements made under the Mission so far and the steps taken/to be taken to achieve the goal of the Mission within stipulated time?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE (IC) FOR YOUTH AFFAIRS & SPORTS AND MINISTER OF STATE FOR WATER RESOURCES, RIVER DEVELOPMENT AND GANGA REJUVENATION (SHRI VIJAY GOEL)

- (a) 86 sewerage infrastructure projects have been sanctioned under Namami Gange Program up to 31st December, 2016. Out of this, 35 projects have been completed. In addition, construction/modernization of 179 Ghats and 116 crematoria have been sanctioned in current financial year. Details of the projects are at Annexure I.
- (b) The sanctioned cost of the projects is Rs 9689.56 Crore. A sum of Rs. 2316.8 Cr. has been released to the States for sewerage infrastructure projects. Details are at

Annexure - II.

(c) Various steps have been taken by the Govt. to achieve goals of the Mission within stipulated time. The steps taken include creation of a new institutional structure for policy and implementation in fast track manner which empowers National Mission for Clean Ganga to discharge its functions in an independent and accountable manner. National Mission for Clean Ganga have been given higher financial powers to sanction projects. The management structure of NMCG has also been strengthened. Projects under Namami Gange are now funded fully from the Centre. Monitoring mechanism has also been strengthened.
