STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (c) OF STARRED QUESTION NO.438 TO BE ANSWERED IN THE LOK SABHA ON 07.08.2014 REGARDING SUPER CRITICAL THERMAL POWER PLANTS.

- (a) : The details of super critical thermal power plants under operation/construction by NTPC during 12th Five Year Plan are given at Annex-I.
- (b): The details of the estimated amount of coal required for the purpose and the manner in which the regular supply of coal is to be met, plant-wise are given at Annex-II.
- (c): The details of contractors for main plant equipments are given at Annex-III.

In respect of resources to fund the projects, NTPC finances its capital expenditure in the ratio of 70:30 (Debt: Equity). Equity is organised through internal accruals. The debt is raised on the basis of Company's Balance sheet instead of raising it for each project, therefore, no project wise break-up of debt is available.
