Sports Infrastructure in Jammu and Kashmir

THE MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) FOR YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS (SHRI VIJAY GOEL) (a)to (c) : No, Madam. However, a special development package of Rs. 200 crores for the state of Jammu & Kashmir is under implementation. SAI has started these courses and the first two courses for 59 persons and for 62 persons were conducted during November 2016 to February, 2017 and the 3rd course for 69 persons is being conducted during March-April, 2017. Once these community coaches are deployed they would be able to identify and nurture young talent.
