Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Air India organises refresher training programmes for its Cabin Crew on regular basis and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Cabin Crew who are not flying for a period of 90 days are required to undergo refresher training programme again; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof?

Answer

Minister of State in the Ministry of CIVIL AVIATION (Shri G. M. Siddeshwara)

- (a): Yes Madam. Refresher Training are regularly conducted in accordance with the Civil Aviation Requirements, Section-7, series M, Part-I dated 15th March, 2010 laid down by the Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA).
- (b) and (c): Yes Madam. As per DGCA CAR, Section-7, series M, Part-I dated 15th March, 2010, Refresher Training of 02 programmed days/12 hours (with additional 04 hours for each additional aircraft type approved) is mandatory for cabin crew, which is absent from active flight duties from 3 months to 6 months but are within the validity of the previous training.
