Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether a huge quantity of Phensydyl Cough Syrup and Hemp (Ganja) is reported as stolen from Customs Godowns at Naxalbari and Siliguri at West Bengal State Warehousing Corporation premises during 2009-13;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government has conducted any enquiry against the customs employee posted at the said office and if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) if not, the reasons therefor?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRIMATI NIRMALA SITHARAMAN)

(a) & (b) Yes. The details of four cases of theft of Phensedyl Cough Syrup and Hemp (Ganja) from Customs Godowns at Naxalbari and Silguri at West Bengal State Warehousing Corporation premises during 2009-13 are as under:

Naxalbari Customs Division: In the year 2012-2013, a quantity of 12900 bottles of Phensedyl Cough Syrup (100 ml each) valued Rs.10.32 lakhs and 840 kgs of Ganja valued at Rs.25.20 lakhs were stolen.

Siliguri Customs Division: In the year 2012-2013, a quantity of 92250 bottles of Phensedyl Cough Syrup (100 ml each) valued at Rs.72.86 lakhs and a quantity of 4300 bottles of Phensedyl Cough Syrup valued at Rs. 2.15 lakhs were stolen.

- (c) Yes. Committees constituted to enquire into the incidents have found no evidence of involvement of Customs officials in the theft. However, disciplinary proceedings for negligence/dereliction of duty against 4 officers in all 4 cases have been initiated. FIRs for theft have been lodged with State Police authorities. Police detective teams have initiated enquiries.
- (d) Not applicable in view of (c) above.
