KVS IN RENTED BUILDINGS

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the total number of Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs) in the country which have their own buildings and have all the basic facilities as on date, State/ UT-wise;
- (b) the details of the KVs which are running from rented buildings and have no basic facilities in the country particularly in Bihar as on date, State/ UT-wise;
- (c) the time by which the Government proposes to construct own buildings for KVs and provide basic facilities to those KVs which do not have such infrastructure along with the expenditure likely to be incurred thereon; and
- (d) the details of the action plan chalked out in this regard?

Answer

MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SMT. SMRITI ZUBIN IRANI)

- (a) 701 Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs) presently have their own building with all basic facilities. The State/UT-wise details of 701 Vidyalaya buildings are annexed.
- (b) One Vidyalaya located at Jetpur (Gujarat) with all basic facilities is running in a rented building. In Bihar all functioning schools are running either in permanent buildings or in accommodation provided by the State Government.
- (c) & (d) Construction of own building with provision of basic facilities for KVs is a continuous process. It depends on providing a suitable plot of land as per norms by the sponsoring authorities, submission of drawings and estimates by the construction agencies and availability of funds. As such, no definite time frame can be given in this regard.
