- (e) the time by which the said Bill is likely to be introduced?

(a) to (e): The Central Government is in the process of preparing a bill under which the Indian Institutes of Management (IIMs) may be accorded the status of Institutes of National Importance. Consultation on the subject has been done with the IIMs and based upon inputs received from various stakeholders, a first draft of the bill has been prepared. This bill may be introduced as soon as it is finalized and approved by the Union Cabinet.
