- (a) the number of the Railway crossings constructed on the National Highways across the country including Maharashtra, State-wise;
- (b) whether the Government has prepared any proposal for constructing the overbridge and underpasses on these railway crossings;
- (c) if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the number of surveys conducted in this regard during the last three years?

(a) to (d) Yes Madam. About 1831 railway level crossing have been identified on National Highways in the country. Out of which, 1137 Railway Over Bridge (ROBs)/ Railway Under Bridge including 104 in Maharashtra have already been constructed. Out of the remaining 694 ROB/RUBs including 25 in Maharashtra, 208 are under Setu Bharatam project and 486 under corridor development.
