- (a) whether the Union Government has received any proposal for refilling the site of Jawai Dam in Pali district of Rajasthan;
- (b) if so, whether a draft has been prepared for bringing water from Sabarmati river in Gujarat to the Jawai dam;
- (c) if so, the steps proposed to be taken by the Union Government in this regard; and
- (d) if not, the manner in which the Union Government is likely to deal with the situation of availability of water in Pali district?
