- (a) whether Nepal has constructed big dams in the areas bordering India;
- (b) if so, whether the Government of Nepal has provided information to the Government of India about the construction of the said dams;
- (c) if so, the details about starting point and ending point of these dams and the total length thereof;
- (d) whether Eastern districts in Uttar Pradesh including Lakhimpur have been affected by flood during the last four years due to the construction of the said dams by the Government of Nepal; and
- (e) if so, the action taken thereon?
