(a) to (c) : A long-term Vision with a 15 year perspective up to 2030, a seven year strategy for achievement of the national development agenda (from 2017-18 to 2023-24) along with a three-year Action Plan beyond 31st March 2017, for overall development of the country are all under preparation.

6 interaction meetings were held in 2016 under the Chairmanship of Vice Chairman, NITI Aayog with eminent economists, business editors, agriculture experts, experts in Science & Technology and innovation sector and also experts in defence and internal security matters. The draft for the three year action plan along with 7 year strategy and 15 year Vision document is at an advanced stage of preparation. This exercise is different from the Five Year Plans, as there is no provision of financial allocation to the Ministries/Departments and States/UTs in this approach. Details of the Action Plan would be available when the document is finally published.
