- (a) : Under BSUP component of Jawaharlal Nehru Urban Renewal Mission (JNNURM), 65 cities have been covered all over the country. The Mission period was upto 31.03.2012 which was further extended upto 31.03.2017 for completing on-going work in the projects sanctioned upto 31.03.2012. Thus, no new projects were sanctioned under the Mission for these cities during the last three years.
- (b): City-wise details of funds allocated and utilised under BSUP scheme during the last three years (year-wise) are given at Annexure-I.
- (c): The guidelines for implementation of the scheme are at Annexure-II.
