Will the Minister of URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to provide financial assistance for integrated development of Mumbai to bring it at par with international standards;
- (b) if so, the broad features and details of the plan, indicating phase-wise details and targets conceived thereunder;
- (c) the steps taken/being taken in that direction;
- (d) the amount allocated, released and utilized for this purpose by the State Government of Maharashtra during the last three years and the current year;
- (e) whether there is any proposal to increase the allocation; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT (SHRI M. VENKAI AH NAIDU)

(a) to (c): Urban Development is a State Subject. However, Government of India had launched Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission (JnNURM) on 03-12-2005 for planned integrated urban Infrastructure Development of cities including Mumbai in the Country. The Mission has ended on 31-03-2014.

A new Urban Development Mission is being considered for integrated development of cities including Mumbai. The contours of the Mission have not been finalized.

(d): Details of Additional Central Assistance (ACA) committed and released for utilization during the last three years for the projects sanctioned in the State of Maharashtra under Urban Infrastructure and Governance (UIG) sub-mission of JnNURM and under Urban Infrastructure Development Scheme for Small and Medium Towns (UIDSSMT) are at Annexure-I and Annexure-II. No project has been sanctioned and funds released in the current year.

Details of financial assistance given for procurement of Buses under JnNURM in Mumbai in the State of Maharashtra are at Annexure-III.

Under the Urban Infrastructure Development in Satellite towns around seven mega cities (UIDSST) scheme, financial assistance provided for development of urban infrastructure in State of Maharashtra during the last three years and current year is as under:-
