(a) & (b): Urban Development is a state subject and it is the responsibility of the Urban Local Bodies/Urban Development Authorities/State Governments to earmark spaces for parks, play grounds etc while formulating Master Plans for the respective cities. Ministry of Urban Development has issued guidelines viz. Urban Planning Formulation and Implementation for guidance in the matter. The details of such spaces in metropolitan and other cities are not maintained by this Ministry.
