- (a) to (c): The projects under Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission (JnNURM) are sanctioned for planned development of cities with focus inter-alia on efficiency in urban infrastructure with the objective of beautification of cities. Details of projects sanctioned under Urban Infrastructure and Governance (UIG) sub-mission and Urban Infrastructure Development Scheme for Small and Medium Towns (UIDSSMT) in the State of Maharashtra during the last three years are at Annexure-I and Annexure-II. No proposal has been sanctioned during the current year i.e. 2014-15.
- (d): The Mission has ended on 31.03.2014.
