- (a) the number of Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) established in the country so far, State/UT-Wise;
- (b) whether the Government has initiated any schemes for setting up of new ITIs with central funding; and
- (c) If so, the details of such schemes along with the number of ITIs established and fund provided under these schemes so far, State/UT-wise?

- (a) So far, 11,001 Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) have been established in the country. The State/UT-wise details are at annex.
- (b) Directorate General of Employment & Training, Ministry of Labour & Employment has formulated two schemes titled "Skill Development in 34 Districts Affected by Left Wing Extremism" and "Enhancing Skill Development Infrastructure in NE States & Sikkim" for setting up of new ITIs with central funding.
- (c) Under these two schemes, a total of 48 ITIs are in the process of establishment. The details of these two schemes along with the State/UT-wise number of ITIs to be established and fund provided so far are at annex.
